Health Alert

PENSACOLA – **This Health Alert is in response to bacteria level testing only.** Effective immediately, the Health Department is rescinding the health alert for the following bathing area in Escambia County, Florida:

Bayou Chico at Lakewood Park

The Health Department feels that water quality in this area has improved considerably due to the reduction in bacteria levels.

Effective immediately, the Health Department is issuing a health alert for **Bayou Grande, Navy Point-South of Gibbs Road.**

A health alert remains in effect for **Bayou Texar at Bayview Park.**

The Health Department advises against any water-related activities at the above locations due to the potential for high bacterial levels. The bacteriological sampling occurred during weekly water quality monitoring activities and the level of bacteria has exceeded the level established by state guidelines.

We will continue to monitor the water quality in these areas weekly and routinely advise the public of our results. For more information contact the Escambia County Health Department at 595-6786.
