### Health Alert

PENSACOLA -- Effective immediately, in response to bacteriological sampling only, the Health Department is rescinding the health alert for the following bathing area in Escambia County, Florida:

#### **Gulf of Mexico at Gulf Islands National Seashore-Johnson Beach Area**

The Health Department feels that water quality in this area has improved considerably due to the reduction in bacteria levels.

Effective immediately, the Health Department is issuing health alerts for the following bathing areas in Escambia County, Florida:

#### **Bayou Grande, Navy Point-South of Gibbs Road**

#### **Bayou Texar at Bayview Park**

**Health alerts remain in effect for Bayou Chico at Lakewood Park and Bayou Grande, Navy Point-North of Sunset Avenue Bridge.**

The Health Department advises against any water-related activities at the above locations due to the potential for high bacteria levels. The bacteriological sampling occurred during weekly water quality monitoring activities and the level of bacteria has exceeded the level established by state guidelines.
