Health Alert

PENSACOLA -- Effective immediately, in response to bacteriological sampling only, the Health Department is rescinding the health alert for the following bathing areas in Escambia County, Florida:

**Bayou Grande, Navy Point-North of Sunset Avenue Bridge
Bayou Texar at Bayview Park**

The Health Department feels that water quality in these areas has improved considerably due to the reduction in bacteria levels.

A health alert remains in effect for Bayou Chico at Lakewood Park.

The Health Department advises against any water-related activities at the above location due to the potential for high bacteria levels. The bacteriological sampling occurred during weekly water quality monitoring activities and the level of bacteria has exceeded the level established by state guidelines.

We will continue to monitor the water quality in these areas weekly and routinely advise the public of our results. For more information contact the Escambia County Health Department at 595-6786.
